- Ways to keep training

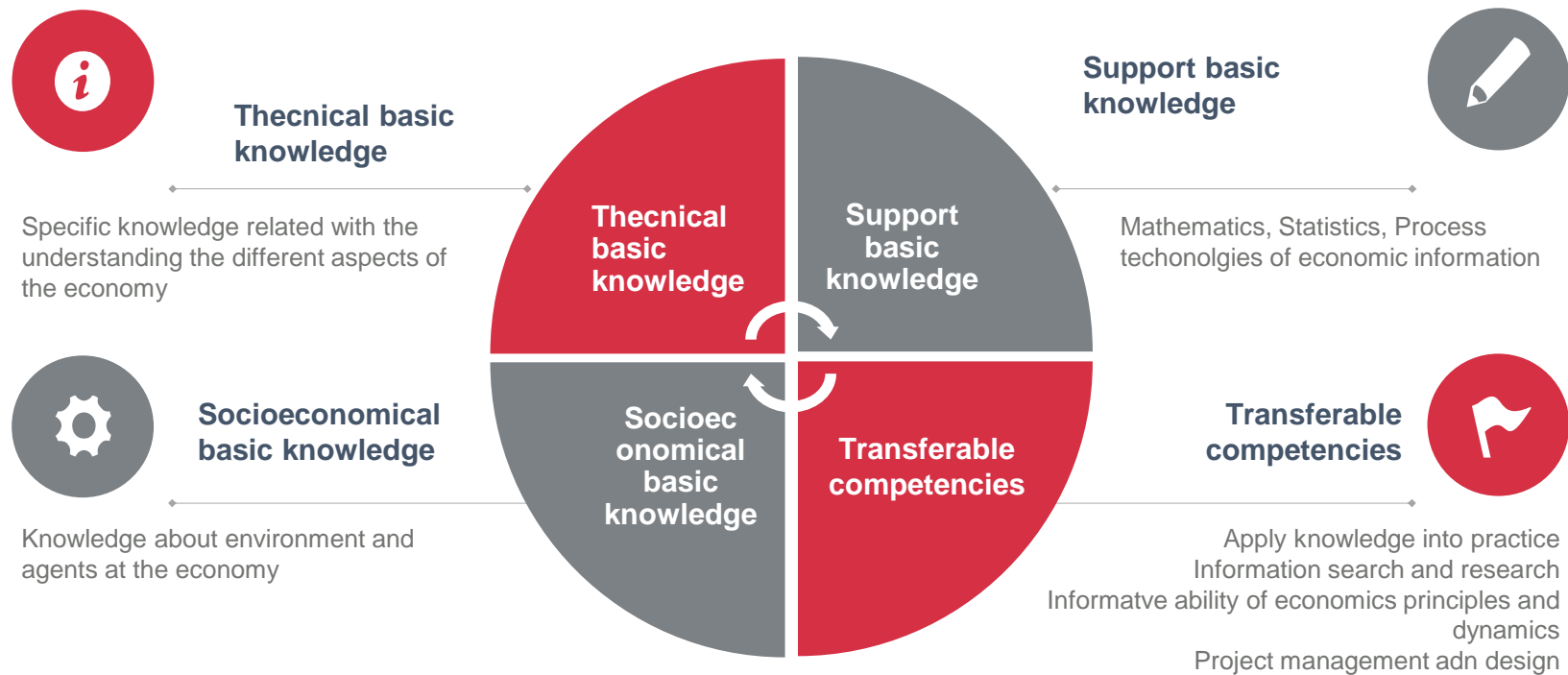
## Decide the main purpose of your graduates

- The aim is to train professionals capable of carrying out management, advisory and assessment tasks in economic matters.
- It is a degree that provides specialized training on the functioning of markets and on the behavior of the different agents that make up economic system
- It also provide to students a solid training in related and complementary areas, such as Finance and Accounting, Business Administration, Marketing and market research
