



# **II. International Credit Mobility**

- Short-term higher education mobility for:
  - Students and PhD candidates (3-12 months)
  - Staff (5-60 days)
  - Trainees (2 to 12 months)
- 150,000 grants over 6 years



- Action managed by National Agencies in Programme Countries
- 2019 budget 18.3 M EUR ~ 4500 scholarships

#### **Organisational support**

EUR 350/participant to the Programme HEI (should be shared with Partner HEI)




#### **Individual support**

€800-900/month to Europe (€140-180/day for staff) €700/month to Partner country (€180/day for staff)



#### **Contribution to travel costs**

€20-1500/participant depending on distance





#### 1. Introduction and objectives

This call for proposals is based on the Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 11 December 2013 establishing 'Erasmus+': the Union Programme for education, training, youth and sport and repealing Decisions No 1719/2006/EC, No 1720/2006/EC and No 1298/2008/EC (<sup>3</sup>) as well as on the 2018 and 2019 Erasmus+ Annual Work Programmes. The Erasmus+ Programme covers the period 2014 to 2020. The general and specific objectives of the Erasmus+ Programme are listed in Articles 4, 5, 11 and 16 of the Regulation.
