Workshop: Collaboration between the IROs/ICOs of universities in Yangon

11th January 2020

Location: University of Yangon, Research Centre Participants: ICO/IRO representatives from universities attending the TOOLKIT project conference in the morning.

Objective:

To consider how the ICOs/IROs of universities in Yangon can collaborate to develop international partnerships and projects with the aim of sharing resources, increasing impact and reducing costs. Collaboration might include:

- Sharing international strategies and agreeing common approaches to explaining the system of higher education in Myanmar.
- Sharing best practice in developing websites, prospectuses and other documents used to promote our universities internationally.
- Joint approaches to welcoming and supporting incoming international exchange students: preparing a shared "Study in Myanmar" guide.
- Sharing the experience of international visits: this might include consideration of a joint delegation to international events and conferences.
- Joint training activities on all aspects of international cooperation.
- Setting up a professional group (Myanmar-wide?) of international cooperation officers.
