




• All participants of the project consortium have responded to the questionnaire.

# Infrastructure and organization


I was satisfied with the quality of communication and interaction between partners before the meeting

• <u>It seems that all respondents were satisfied with quality of communication and interaction</u> between partners before the workshops, with 57.1% strongly agreeing in this aspect.


I was satisfied with the meeting venue and arrangements. 14 responses

• A majority (about 92.1%) of the respondents were satisfied with the hotel accommodations and transportation. The following comments section also reveals that many respondents have commented positively about the arrangements and schedule was well planned. Also, they had a good opportunity to meet everyone in the project, with a face-to-face explanation of the WPs. However, 7.1% have reported their dissatisfaction with those facilities. This could be due to the tight schedule of the meeting and less options on hotel rooms and prices that were available for participants to choose from as mentioned in the comments section.




The explanation of the Project timeline and objectives were useful and clear 14 responses

The presentations by EU partners on HE System and Internationalization in HE were useful and applicable.



The presentations by Asian partners on HE System and Internationalization in HE were useful and applicable.



Working plan for the project is clear, so we could spend time for preparing and collecting the data Planning was done in fruitful manner.



It was clear to me how I and my colleagues had to work with WP 1  $\,$ 



It was clear to me how to structure and distribute questionnaires for WP1 Needs analysis and how to collect data.


